This joint research unit (UMR 5112) of the CNRS (National Center for Scientific Research) is hosted by the University of Montpellier. Founded in 1983, its work focuses on the comparative analysis of the transformation of democratic governments. While initially focused exclusively on the geographical area of Southern Europe, the CEPEL has extended its coverage to the "larger South" and North America.


Practical Information

Get to Montpellier by plane

The Montpellier Méditerranée Airport is located just 8 km from the city center. The drive takes around ten minutes. It is easy to get from the airport to downtown Montpellier by Airport Shuttle, by taxi or thanks to a car rental service.

Get to the airport by tramway

- •Take line 1, going to «Odysseum» and get off at «Place de l'Europe» Tramway Station.
- •Take the Airport Shuttle, line 120.

Get around in Montpellier by tramway

As part of the Montpellier Metropole transport network, managed by TaM, Montpellier's tramway system is the ideal means of public transportation for getting around Montpellier, visiting many local tourist sites, and generally getting to know the area from a new perspective.

A network of 4 tramways lines

The itinerary of the tramway lines:

- Line 1 Mosson/Odysseum
- Line 2 Saint-Jean de Védas Centre / Jacou
- Line 3 Juvignac/Montpellier/Lattes et Pérols
- Line 4 Saint-Denis/ Place Albert 1er

Where can you buy tickets and top-off your transport card?

- At the tourism office.
- At the TaM agency
- •At nearly 130 participating stores and shops
- At 120 automatic distributors

Just on the other side of the street, Tram Stop Line 1. Take line 1 going to « Mosson », and get off at « Louis Blanc ». 50 m walk and turn left in « rue de l'Université », then take the first street on the right : « rue Arc-des-Mourgues ».





Stunning views on the gardens, on the Cathedral and the 12th century Medical University. Ideally located near to the most important cultural attractions of Montpellier.














