Scott B. Gudes of Alexandria, Va. (M.P.A. '78), vice president for government relations for the National Marine Manufacturers Association. Gudes joined NMMA - the nation's leading marine industry trade association - in October, after serving more than 29 years in the federal government. His most recent position during that tenure was as minority staff director of the U.S. Senate Budget Committee. Gudes also served as deputy under secretary of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration during the Clinton and Bush presidencies, and acting administrator in 2001. He oversaw export and trade policy while serving in various leadership posts in the legislative branch. He has been honored with the 2003 Presidential Distinguished Rank Senior Executive Service Award, and in 2007, was presented with the American Meteorological Society's Special Award for furthering environmental education and the National Marine Sanctuary Foundation's leadership award for supporting ocean programs.
