After 17 terms in office, Skelton faced a very tough challenge from evangelical Christian and former state Rep. [Vicky Hartzler](#) (R) and lost his seat in [2010](#).<sup>(1)</sup>

Skelton has represented [Missouri](#)'s overwhelmingly conservative 4th congressional district since 1977 and has spent much of that time on the House Armed Services Committee, currently as chairman. Skelton often finds himself in the middle of the road on social and defense issues.

Skelton has pushed presidents from both parties to increase the size of the standing Army and has fought for troop funding. But he has stuck with the Democratic Party on the management of the Iraq war, first calling for more United Nations inspections and consistently opposing troop increases in Iraq.
